YOUR WINE HOSTS

Ken and Deborah Brown, owners of Ken Brown Wines. Most of Ken's career has been spent pursuing the elusive traits that make great Pinot Noir. From his early days as founding winemaker at Zaca Mesa Winery to his 20-year tenure at Byron Vineyard to the small family operation at Ken Brown Wines, Ken has continued to experiment with clones, rootstocks and winemaking techniques, exploring the tremendous potential for Pinot Noir in Santa Barbara County. His focus is on very small lots of Pinot Noir from the finest vineyards of Sta. Rita Hills. The wines are hand crafted by legendary winemaker Ken Brown (Byron Kent Brown), and most lots consist of 250 cases or less. Ken works with growers, many of whom he has known for years, to hand select vineyard blocks for each program. He also produces limited bottlings of Syrah and Chardonnay. Ken, his wife, Deborah, and their small staff enjoy close relationships with the wines and their customers.

SAMsARA owners Joan and Dave Szkutak, in partnership with winemaker Matt Brady, focus on showcasing the unique and expressive terroir of the Sta. Rita Hills and proximate cool-climate vineyards. We aim to make honest, balanced wines in small lots that are true to place and vintage. We hand sort, foot stomp and use natural yeasts from the vineyard to achieve purity and complexity in each varietal we produce. We believe in sustainability from the vineyard to our SIP certified winery, which includes not only organics, and hand-farming, but also cultural sustainability from the farmers to our employees to our guests. SAMsARA produces limited releases of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Syrah, and Grenache from carefully selected micro-sites within Sta. Rita Hill's most distinctive vineyards.
