Louizos and Alexandra Papadopoulos are the founders and owners of Molon Lave Vineyards, located in Warrenton, Virginia. Louizos, the winemaker, grew up amongst the vineyards at the family farm between ancient Corinth and the famous Nemea region, near Athens, Greece. Molon Lave Vineyards is a boutique farm winery specializing in producing handcrafted wines based on the principles of traditional European winemaking techniques, which include Kosher wines. Since 2009, their winery features three active generations of family, who bring a proud and personal touch to the business, from vineyard to cellar to tasting room.

Philip Carter Strother and Danielle Strother. Rich history can be found beneath your feet throughout Fauquier County and that stands true at the Philip Carter Winery, owned and maintained by Philip Carter Strother and his family with a legacy weighing in at three centuries. The Philip Carter Winery carries the distinction as the first American wine family to receive international recognition for wine excellence dating back to October 20, 1762. Philip is also an attorney and has served as the Chairman of the Fauquier Wine Council, Chairman of the Virginia Wine Council, and as legal counsel to many Virginia wineries he was the legal architect for the deregulation of the Virginia wine industry in the 2000s.

John and Marialisa Delmare are the founders and proprietors of Rappahannock Cellars, a successful 20,000 case boutique winery in the Blue Ridge Mountains of Virginia producing world class still and sparkling wines from grapes including Cabernet Franc, Chardonnay, Viognier, and Petit Verdot. In 1991 the Delmare's founded and operated Saratoga Vineyards in the Santa Cruz Mountains of California and had the honor to make wine from vineyards dating to 1909. In 1996 the Delmare's passed on the reins of Saratoga Vineyards and moved their growing family and their love of wine growing to Virginia. There they found thriving many of the same grape varieties they farmed in California. Fast forward to 2023, now with over 30 years of experience in growing grapes and crafting wine, the Delmare's continue to operate Rappahannock Cellars and a small brandy distillery "Dida's Distillery", hand in hand with four of their twelve grown children.
