DAY 1: OCTOBER 5, 2028

EMBARKATION – SAINT-JEAN-DE-LOSNE (PORT OF DIJON), FRANCE

Board your ship in preparation for your 7-night Flavors of Burgundy cruise. (D)

DAY 2: OCTOBER 6, 2028

PORT OF DIJON, – SEURRE, FRANCE

Explore the medieval streets of Dijon, steeped in history and culture, or visit the architectural marvel of Château d'Arcelot. Wine enthusiasts can enjoy a guided bike tour along the Saône River, taking in the scenic vineyards and charming landscapes that have shaped Burgundy's renowned wine heritage. (B,L,D)



DAY 3: OCTOBER 7, 2028

SEURRE – CHALON-SUR-SAÔNE, FRANCE

Visit the town of Beaune, a walled town nestled in the heart of Cote d'Or vineyards where you'll stroll the cobblestone streets and take in such sights as the mosaic-tiled roof of the Hospices de Beaune, founded in the 15th century as a hospital for the less fortunate. Guests interested in wine making can learn more about cooperage, or the art of making wine barrels, in this interactive workshop that guides you through the process of crafting barrels through traditional methods. You may also join a guided tour through Seurre, unraveling its rich tapestry of heritage and charm. In the afternoon, enjoy a scenic sailing by the picturesque city of Chalon-sur-Saône. Alternatively, sample the highly esteemed vintages from the Côtes de Nuits region on a guided wine tasting, surrounded by the oaken casks and intricately tiled roofs that bring this sommelier's fantasy to life. DAY 4: OCTOBER 8, 2028

CHALON-SUR-SAÔNE – TOURNUS, FRANCE

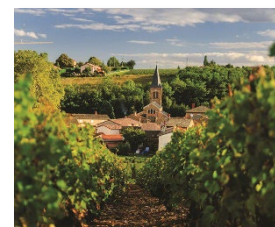
Immerse yourself in the heart of the Côte Chalonnaise as you explore Chalon-sur-Saône on a historic tour or guided bike ride, then savor the region's renowned Chalonnaise wines before continuing to Tournus by river or on an invigorating cycling route through Burgundy's celebrated vineyards. DAY 5: OCTOBER 9, 2028

TOURNUS – MÂCON, FRANCE

Today you have a choice of a number of excursions as you explore the cities of Tournus and Mâcon. Let your knowledgeable guide lead you through Tournus and to its magnificent Benedictine Abbey of Saint Philibert. Or choose instead to visit the moated Château de Cormatin, which dates back to the early 17th century and features ornate apartments as well as a beautifully manicured garden. As an alternative, venture to the medieval village of Brancion with its preserved gateway, church and market hall. Return to the ship and enjoy a scenic cruise to Mâcon. Or, instead, join a guided bike tour from Tournus to Mâcon or go wine tasting and meet the ship in Mâcon. (B,L,D)



DAY 6: OCTOBER 10, 2028

MÂCON, FRANCE

Discover Mâcon's rich winemaking heritage on a guided tour through its famed vineyards and historic streets, or explore the impressive Cluny Abbey and nearby Berzé-le-Châtel castle, with the option for active travelers to take in the region's scenic landscapes on a guided bike ride. (B,L,D)



DAY 7: OCTOBER 11, 2028

LYON, FRANCE

Raise a glass to your Burgundy adventure with a Beaujolais wine tasting before exploring Lyon, a UNESCO World Heritage gem and France's culinary capital. Food lovers can indulge in a tasting at the legendary Les Halles Market, while active guests may cycle through Lyon's riverfront boulevards. (B,L,D)
